- Funding
 - HSI available funds (prioritize supporting Latinx and other minority students)

- Plan to maintain at least 25% undergrad enrollment (especially when expanding UG enrollment upon adding Human Services degree) - Bachelor's degree that will feed into the Master's in Counseling Program (this is still in development)
 - Database of other HSIs (and MSIs) and what they are doing to maintain the 25% minimum enrollment.
- Student Survey
 - PULSO finished the short version of the survey – will check about the status and sending it to students
 - PULSO is working on the long IRB survey that will hopefully be completed by the end of the quarter.
- Support for Latinx students at PAU
 - Create a mentoring pipeline through grants to begin attracting high school/college students.
 - Add mentorship presentations to resources in website
 - Figure out action items – ask alumni of what they would have liked and what they think students need.
 - Coalition with Diaspora and other minority groups at PAU
- Send a note about César Chávez day on May 31st.
- Asking External Affairs to incorporate new designations in brand assets to increase diversified recruitment.
